My maternal grandfather was Benjamin James Whittington. He was the son of a minister and grew



up near Columbus, Indiana. As a young man, he moved to Arkansas where he found work, fell in love, and married my grandmother. They reared eight children during hard economic times. To make ends meet, the family traveled wherever they could make a living. My mother and her twin sister, for example, were born in Southern California near the Mexican border while my grandfather worked in the fruit harvest. Later the family lived near Smackover, Arkansas, where he toiled as a laborer in the oil field. Finally, they ended up in Northwest Arkansas where my mother and father met.

Benjamin Whittington was an uneducated man with a poet's heart. He penned a booklet titled <u>Arkansas Poems</u>. One of the poems in his collection I committed to memory years ago and have quoted it each Christmas in the pulpit for more than fifty years. Most of you have heard it; and some have asked for a copy. It is a retelling of the story of the Wise Men in Matthew 2:1-12.

The Birth of Christ

While all nature, wrapt in slumber, In that Orient land afar Journeyed wise men to Judea; They were guided by a star.

Into Herod's court they wandered To ascertain if it be known Where the newborn Jewish ruler Was to reign upon the throne.

To their story Herod listened, Then he bade them make it clear To his mind, if they remembered When the star did first appear.

- "Go, and search 'til you have found Him, When returning, passing through, Bring me word where he's residing That I may him go worship, too."
  - But in a dream the men had warning How King Herod would employ All the means that he commanded The young child's life to destroy.
- So when the men homeward journeyed, Weary from travel night and day, Being warned of Herod's purpose, They passed by another way.

Now Herod, in a fit of anger That no previous monarch knew, Put to death all male children From the cradle up to two.

But this child now safe in Egypt In accord with God's command This, the way God chose to save Him From the blood-stained Herod's hand.

Herod's reign soon terminated, Death doth end the rule of man, Beyond death, man cannot govern Whate'er hath been his previous plan.

This child shall reign forever, And his praise the nations sing, For despite man's opposition He is Lord of Lords and King of Kings!
