FROM MY HEART TO YOURS:

New Office Building

On Wednesday evening, December 12, the church voted to

build a four thousand square foot Office Building. The new building will house offices for the church staff, a conference room which also can be used for Sunday School, and a prayer room. The current church offices will be freed up for Sunday School expansion near the Sanctuary, and located more conveniently for older adults.

The following four-fold recommendation was approved:

- That the church authorize the Church Trustees to enter into a contract with Moser Construction Company for the construction of an Office Building complying with the design and specifications prepared by the church architect in the amount of \$724,975.* The contract is also to include terms recommended by the architect for the construction time line and compliance with all codes; and
- That the church approve the use of existing funds for payment to Moser Construction Company using a payment schedule based on stages of completed construction as defined by the contract; and
- That the church approve arranging for a line of credit with a local bank for up to \$100,000 at the most favorable terms obtainable. This line of credit is to be used only if and when needed to complete the new building; and
- That the church approve a fund-raising drive for donations and pledges to pay for the building without having to use the line of credit or to make payments to retire the loan if needed.
- *Additional costs related to civil redesign, architect fees, sub-surface foundation unknowns, and contingency bring the total to \$793,204.

The good news is that the church already has 90% of the funds needed for the building project. We are only about \$79,000 short. In the past two months the church has received gifts totaling \$46,031 from the estates of deceased members. During the same period we received \$35,000 in direct gifts toward the building. Funds are coming in guickly. Wouldn't it be great if we can finish this building project without having to borrow any money? You may want to consider an endof-the-year gift for tax purposes and to benefit the church. Pray about the part the Lord would have you play to help our church move forward and reach more people for Christ through this additional space. To God be the glory!

I want to express deep appreciation in behalf of the congregation to Alan Farrow, Chairman of the Space Design Team, and those who served with him over many months to develop the plans for the new building. Others on the team are Tom Belin, Tony Gaston, Tom Hensley, and Van Steed. Also, we thank members of our Finance Committee for their expertise and faithfulness in guiding the financial aspects of the project. The Finance Committee consists of Lloyd Thrash, Chairman, Tom Belin, Jean Eskew, Kendall Gilmer, Sharon Hensley, and Grady Waggoner.
