FROM MY HEART TO YOURS:

New Office Building

Plans are moving forward rapidly toward the construction of our new office building. The church has

signed a contract with Moser Construction Company for \$724.975. Groundbreaking has taken place, with six months needed for completion.

The total cost of the building is estimated to be \$793,204. This additional cost beyond the contract price includes the remaining architect fees, sub-surface foundation unknowns, possible redesign, and a contingency.

Thankfully, in late December we received gifts toward the building totaling \$26,000. This means we are short less than \$50,000 in funds needed to complete the project. Our goal is to raise the remaining funds during construction and enter the building debt free. Your faithfulness and generosity will make this possible.

You will be pleased to know that the church had a banner year in budget giving during 2018. We received \$617,168 in tithes and offerings. At the same time, our expenses were \$540,578, leaving a surplus of \$76,590. If we continue this trend of giving and hold expenses down, which we intend to do, then surplus money can be applied toward the building or to help with renovation costs of our current office space to make it ready for Sunday School classes near the Sanctuary.

Pray about the part you and your family will have in helping our church to move forward and reach more people.

Loving Others

Years ago I made a mission trip to the Amazon region of Brazil, representing Arkansas Baptists. I visited the major river cities of Manaus, Santarem, and Belem. At Santarem I worked with missionaries Richard and Bea Walker. Late one night Richard and I engaged in deep conversation. I asked about his call to missions and what he was trying to accomplish in his work. He acknowledged that a lack of response was one of the most difficult aspects of being a missionary. He then made a statement about loving others that I will never forget. "Love is the unsolicited giving of the best you have in behalf of another regardless of the response." I grabbed my pen and notebook and wrote down Walker's definition of love. Later that night I tried to find a comfortable position in my hammock that would allow me to sleep. With the boat rocking back and forth on the Amazon River, I pondered what it means to love others, whatever the cost or the response. Love is something more than a feeling or an emotion. "Love is something you do," so says Frederick Speakman. May we find specific ways to show our love.
